EVENTOR EMERGENCY CONTACT CHANGES

EVENTOR MANDATORY CONTACT FIELD CHANGES

(1) Emergency Contact Details

In late May, SOFT implemented EWG Change Request #19 (Emergency Contact Field Changes). Details of which can be found here – [Eventor Change Request #19](#).

In summary, a member or casual's profile now contains separate fields for an Emergency Contact Mobile and an Emergency Contact Name.

Both fields are mandatory.

The previous My profile > Contact Emergency Contact details looked like:

As noted in the change request, as part of the change, a script was run to separate the existing data into text and numeric and to populate the new fields with the 'new' data.

If any member, or casual, who previously had not provided any emergency contact details, logs in to their profile, as both fields are now mandatory, the member will be required to provide any missing information to be able to log out successfully.

(2) Mandatory Contact Details

In addition to the above change, Change Request #18 (Mandatory Contact Fields Consistency) was implemented to the My pages > Contact details tab to ensure mandatory fields are consistent for registered users, casuals, and club members.

The change included email address and State becoming mandatory across all registered users.

(3) Recommendations

Orienteering Australia recommends that State Associations make their members aware and request them to review and update their emergency contact details as required.
